The physician members of the Joint Subcommittee recommended and the Board accepted NAACOG certification in lieu of a certificate of graduation from an approved NP educational program.

VII. NP Joint Subcommittee Meeting - December 3, 1989

Members of the Joint Subcommittee meet on Sunday morning, December 3, 1989, to conduct the following business:

- A. Recommendation from the nursing members regarding NAACOG certification - approved by the Joint Subcommittee
- B. Cynthia Eaton, currently approved as an ANP, wishes to change her title to FNP as a result of additional training. The Joint Subcommittee adopted a motion that Ms. Eaton be allowed to apply for approval as an FNP furnishing the required educational documentation.

C. Proposed NP Rules and Formulary

1. The Joint Subcommittee members discussed in detail the proposed rules and agreed upon several wording changes. The proposed rules as adopted by the Joint Subcommittee are attached.
2. The Joint Subcommittee adopted a motion that the physician members will take the changes in the rules proposed by the Joint Subcommittee back to the Board of Medical Examiners at its January 1990 meeting.

Specifically, the Board of Nursing requests that a countersigning time of five working days be considered instead of five days and that under parenteral medications which may be prescribed, epinephrine and benadryl be added to the Rules and the Formulary.

3. The Joint Subcommittee discussed the pro rata division of NP fees and adopted a motion that only the \$75 fee collected for applications handled by both Boards will be split 50/50.

PHEP SUBCOMMITTEE REPORT

On November 30, 1989, Dr. Stratas presented the PHEP Subcommittee Report. He noted that PHEP indicated there was a need for \$20,000 in addition to what has already been budgeted. The PHEP Subcommittee reviewed all of the program cases and anonymous cases.

MANDATORY REPORTING - ROANOKE CHOWAN HOSPITAL

On December 1, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Henry and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board write the administrator of the hospital that, under the requirements of G.S. 14.13, he is indeed to report to the Board of Medical Examiners any change in status, e.g., medical leave of absence.

ADMINISTRATIVE RULE HEARING

The hearing was called to order at 8:30 a.m. on Friday, December 1, 1989.

Notice for this hearing was run in the September 15th issue of the North Carolina Register as required by the Administrative Procedure Act.

The N.C. Board of Medical Examiners, pursuant to authority vested in it by General Statutes 90-9 and 90-14, proposed to amend rules contained in Chapter 21 of the North Carolina Administrative Code. These amendments if adopted will become effective March 1, 1990 after proper filing and review procedures are followed by the Office of Administrative Hearings.

The subjects to be addressed at this hearing are:

- (1) The rules requiring U.S.A. or Canadian citizenship or immigrant status have been repealed or amended to delete all mention of citizenship from the Board's rules. This action was handled on an emergency temporary basis following the required procedures. The rules are now proposed to be repealed or amended on a permanent basis.
- (2) A rule is proposed which if adopted will set standards of practice; specifically, prescribing activities.

Persons interested were instructed in the advertisement in the N.C. Register that written or oral statements relevant to the actions proposed may be presented at this hearing. Two written statements have been received at the Board's office; Julian Bobbitt, Attorney, and G. Dan Roberson, M.D.

Thad Wester, M.D. appeared on behalf of the Department of Public Health. He indicated that the proposed rule on prescribing causes considerable concern, especially as it relates to the doctor/patient relationship as written, and would be devastating in the areas of immunizations, sexually transmitted disease clinics, TB clinics, and in epidemics. Dr. Wester indicated that if the intent of the proposed rule is to address the abuse of controlled substances or mind-altering substances, he would like the Board to consider alternative wording. He then presented a revised rule for the Board to take under advisement.

Dr. Patterson: It also would be devastating to every hospice program. My wife is a hospice nurse. If we adopt this rule, every hospice will not be able to perform. Every person who needs a change in pain medication would have to come to the ER. We are doing a grave disservice.

Dr. Henry: Every patient in the hospice program has a physician because of the nature of his disease. The rules and regulations are such that they would fall within the scope of the rule.

Dr. Patterson: That implies that if the patient needs increased pain medication, there must be documentation of a physical examination, etc. If that is not the intent . . .

Dr. Henry: The spirit of the regulation . . . the patient had a physician by the physician. Example, a cancer patient . . . it would be documented in the chart.

Dr. Patterson: Your interpretation of the spirit any my interpretation of Paragraph 2 are entirely different. I think that whatever point in time, we need to make it clearer.

Dr. Nance: What constitutes a physical examination?

This hearing was adjourned at 8:45 a.m. on December 1, 1989.

As a result of the discussion that took place, Dr. Daniel appointed Dr. Patterson and Dr. Henry to bring a proposal back to the Board at its January 1990 meeting.

CAPLINGER, Gerald - Blowing Rock, NC

On December 1, 1989, Mr. Paris reported that Mr. Caplinger has been found guilty of practicing medicine without a license.

McLEAN, Harry Hemdon, III, M.D. - Winterville, NC

On November 30, 1989, the Board adopted the following motion made by Dr. Godwin and seconded by Dr. Henry that the Board extend Dr. McLean's temporary license until August 31, 1990 limited to his working no more than forty-eight (48) hours per week.

EMS REPORT

Dr. Nance, the Board's Liaison Representative to the Office of Emergency Medical Services, presented the ALS application report to the full Board.

On December 2, 1989 the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Nance and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board approve the 114 initial applications and 107 recertification applications for Advanced Life Support personnel submitted by the Office of Emergency Medical Services. The Board also adopted a motion made by Dr. Nance and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board approve the 216 Bee Sting Certifications submitted by the Office of Emergency Medical Services.

On December 2, 1989, Dr. Daniel presented a report on the public hearing regarding the proposed changes to the MICN rules which was held on November 3, 1989. As a result of this report, on December 2, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Daniel and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board approve the following changes to the MICN rules:

1. Inclusion of external cardiac pacing for EMT-Advanced Intermediates and EMT-Paramedics;
2. Inclusion of language which will permit the administration of approved medications via the endotracheal tube for EMT-Advanced Intermediates and sublingual medication administration for EMT-Advanced Intermediates and EMT-Paramedics.

Dr. Daniel reported that some intraosseous infusion lines have been done in a life and death situation. It was pointed out by Dr. Henry that this procedure has not been approved. As a further result of this report, on December 2, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Nance and seconded by Dr. Henry that the Board table the following change to the MICN rules until such time as the Board receives documentation as to how many of the procedures have been done and the outcome of each procedure (Dr. Patterson recommended contacting Dr. Milewski) and that EMS is told that, in the meantime, they are not to perform such procedures:

3. Inclusion of intraosseous infusion lines in patients under 24 months of age by EMT-Advanced Intermediates and EMT-Paramedics.

On December 2, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Nance and seconded by Dr. Alexander that the Board not approve the following change to the MICN rules and that the Board write Dr. Joseph Moylan who is on the Trauma Committee of the American College of Surgeons for his comments on the proposal:

4. Inclusion of the pharyngo-tracheal lumen (PTL) airway as an alternative airway at the EMT-Intermediate, EMT-Advanced Intermediate and EMT-Paramedic levels.

On December 2, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Henry that EMS personnel are to perform only those procedures which have been approved by the Board.

On December 1, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Daniel and seconded by Dr. Henry that the Board approve the following changes to the MICN rules:

- Addition of D50w at the EMT-Intermediate level
- Allowing EMT-Intermediates to start a peripheral intravenous line on a pulseless non-breathing patient prior to contacting the sponsor hospital when working with an EMT-Paramedic.

MESSER, Virgil Marvin, M.D. - Waynesville, NC

On December 2, 1989, the Board adopted the following motion made by Dr. Godwin and seconded by Dr. Daniel that the Board grant Dr. Messer a six month temporary license, expiration date May 31, 1990.

PHYSICIANS APPROVED FOR LICENSURE BY ENDORSEMENT & EXAMINATION

On December 2, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Mrs. Willis that the Board issue licenses to the following physicians on the basis of endorsement of credentials or written examination.

HAYES, Albert Drake, M.D. - Shelby, NC


