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MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER

Jack A. Koontz, M.D., President, called this meeting to order at 9:00 p.m., Wednesday, October 8, 1986. Board members present were: Charles Howard Duckett, M.D., Secretary; Eben Alexander, Jr., M.D.; David S. Citron, M.D.; John Thomas Daniel, Jr., M.D.; Harold L. Godwin, M.D.; and Mrs. Martha Kirkland Walston. Hector Himel Henry, II, M.D., who will be a member of the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina effective November 1, 1986, also attended this meeting.

Staff members present included: Bryant D. Paris, Jr.; Don Pittman; William H. Breeze, Jr.; Kathy Burke, and Sibyl Lamoreaux.

BOYD, ARTHUR B., M.D.

The President instructed that, even though it is past the deadline, the Board of Medical Examiners will permit Dr. Boyd to take FLEX Component I and II in December, 1986. The Board unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Koontz that the Board send Dr. Boyd a letter stating:

As a result of your interview with the Board of Medical Examiners on October 11, 1986, during which the Board considered your application for a license to practice medicine in this state, the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina advises that, at the present time, you are not qualified for licensure in this state. However, the Board will accept your application to take FLEX in North Carolina during December, 1986. This is a special exception and you must apply within two weeks from receipt of this letter. The Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion that the Board send this correspondence and all future correspondence to Dr. Boyd certified, return receipt requested.

BERTELS, NORMAN H., M.D.

The Board unanimously adopted a motion that the Board of Medical Examiners issue Dr. Bertels a resident's training license based on compliance with certain conditions and that the Board of Medical Examiners outline in a letter to Dr. Bertels these conditions:

1. Dr. Bertels may prescribe controlled substances within the confines of his Anesthesiology Residency Program

at Bowman Gray School of Medicine.

- 2. Dr. Bertels shall regularly attend NA and AA meetings.
- Dr. Bertels shall submit to random drug screens by C.O.D.A.
- 4. Dr. Bertels shall continue his participation in the Physicians Health and Effectiveness Program under the the direction of Theodore Clark, M.D., in Pinehurst, North Carolina.
- Dr. Bertels shall participate in psychiatry therapy at intervals deemed necessary by his therapist.
- 6. Dr. Bertels shall submit quarterly reports to the Board from the Director of his Residency Training Program and from Dr. Clark.
- 7. Dr. Bertels shall appear before the Board for an interview during the June, 1987, meeting, at which time the Board of Medical Examiners will consider whether to extend his resident's training license.

BUNN, DAVID GLENN, M.D.

The Board unanimously adopted a motion that it issue Dr. Bunn a dated license for a period of one year; that it endorse prescribing privileges for Dr. Bunn in Schedules 3, 4, and 5; that the Board not endorse prescribing privileges for Dr. Bunn in Schedules 2 and 2N; that the Board of Medical Examiners direct Dr. Bunn to continue participation in AA; that it direct specifically, to continue participation in the Physicians Health and Effectiveness Committee's program in Pinehurst; that it instruct Dr. Bunn to provide progress reports from Dr. Clark at six month intervals; that the Board instruct Dr. Bunn to obtain at least fifty hours of continuing medical education prior to the October, 1987, meeting; that it advise Dr. Bunn an investigator will subpoena some patient records prior to this physician's next interview with the Board of Medical Examiners; that the Board request Dr. Bunn to appear for an interview at the October, 1987, meeting; and that the Board of Medical Examiners advise Dr. Bunn of this action in writing.

HANHAM, WILLIAM JAMES, M.D.

The Board unanimously adopted a motion that the Board of Medical Examiners will advise Dr. Hanham by letter that the Board will issue him a dated license for a period of one year based on the following conditions:

- The Board of Medical Examiners will permit Dr. Hanham to prescribe Schedule 2 and 2N controlled substances only to hospitalized patients and to patients whose records document they are suffering from cancer.
- 2. The Board of Medical Examiners will periodically monitor Dr. Hanham's practice pattern.
- 3. The Board of Medical Examiners will notify Dr. Hanham to appear for an interview at its October, 1987, meeting.

MCGRADY, KATHLEEN R., M.D.

The Board unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Fitz that the Board of Medical Examiners accept as information a letter from this physician and thank Dr. McGrady for her response.

PELHAM, RICHARD, M.D.

The Board unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board of Medical Examiners write Dr. Pelham a letter stating:

Due to an administrative oversight, the Board of Medical Examiners failed to renew your dated license. Effective the date your previous license expired, the Board retrospectively approves your licensure based on the conditions listed in the Consent Order of March 14, 1985, and extends this approval through January 31, 1988.

Moreover, the Board will interview you again during its December, 1986, meeting and will advise you of the time and place for this interview approximately two weeks prior to the meeting.

HOPKINS, RICHARD GLENN, M.D.

The Board unanimously adopted a motion that the Board of Medical Examiners inform Dr. Hopkins the Board has dismissed the charges previously preferred against him; the Board congratulates him for complying with the conditions of the proposed Consent Order; the Board commends him for demonstrating his medical knowledge by passing Component II of FLEX; the Board advises it will review several of his patient records within a year; and the Board further advises it may request him to appear for another informal interview.

DALTON, FRANKLIN, M.D.

The Board unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board deny Dr. Dalton's request for reinstatement of his medical license.

The Board unanimously adopted a motion to accept a report concerning Dr. Blackburn as information.

Baker, Herbert Marvin, M.D.

The Board unanimously adopted a motion to dismiss the charges previously preferred against Dr. Baker and to instruct an investigator to monitor Dr. Baker's practice activities.

Kreplick, Joseph, M.D.

The Board unanimously adopted a motion that the staff obtain a copy of the Massachusetts Consent Order as soon as possible and present this information for the Board of Medical Examiners' review.

Heaphy, Leo Joseph, Jr., M.D.

The Board unanimously adopted a motion that the staff obtain copies of the formal actions taken by the Texas Board against Dr. Heaphy and that Board of Medical Examiners attempt to

effect a licensure surrender.

Rogers, Richard Lionel, M.D.

Mr. Weddington reported that, in accordance with the action of the Board, he has prepared the charges to be preferred against this physician.

Ott, David James, M.D.

The Board unanimously adopted a motion to accept as information a report indicating the attorney for the Board of Medical Examiners has, in accordance with the action of the Board, prepared the charges to be preferred against Dr. Ott.

Rogers, Charles Wilburn, M.D.

The Board unanimously adopted a motion that it schedule a continuation hearing on charges preferred against Dr. Rogers at the December, 1986, meeting.

Fry, Harold H., Jr., M.D.

TODD, GARY PRICE, M.D.

Bill Breeze presented a report concerning this physician. On October 9, 1986, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Koontz and seconded by Dr. Alexander that the Board prefer charges against Dr. Todd based on North Carolina G.S. 90-14 (6) Unprofessional conduct, specifically, with regard to printed statements concerning his publication. On October 9, 1986, the Board of Medical Examiners also adopted a motion made by Dr. Koontz and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board prefer additional charges against Dr. Todd based on North Carolina G.S. 90-14 (12) Sale of Drugs in such a way as to exploit patients for Financial Gain.

WALLACE, RAYMOND DEWEY, M.D.

The Board reviewed information indicating that Dr. Wallace passed Component II of FLEX. The Board unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board of Medical Examiners request Dr. Wallace to appear for an informal interview at the December, 1986, meeting of the Board.

COMPLAINTS, REVIEWING POLICY

On October 9, 1986, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Citron that the Board distribute a primary complaint file to one Board member, provide a copy of the file to another member, and act upon the recommendations of the reviewers.

FUTURE BOARD MEETINGS

On October 9, 1986, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion that the Board hold all future meetings with the exception of the May meeting at the North Raleigh Hilton.

MINUTES OF THE JUNE, 1986, MEETING

On October 9, 1986, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board approve these Minutes.

MINUTES OF THE AUGUST, 1986, MEETING

On October 9, 1986, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board approve these Minutes with the addition

of a statement indicating that Dr. Godwin voted in opposition to the motion to approve the administration of Nitrous Oxide by Emergency Medical Services personnel.

HARTMAN, GEORGE EDWARD, M.D.

On October 9, 1986, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board prefer charges against Dr. Hartman on the basis of unprofessional conduct, that an investigator personally deliver the charges to George Edward Hartman, M.D.; and that the Board of Medical Examiners subpoena the hospital records concerning Dr. Hartman's suspension of privileges.

WEATHERS, BAILEY GRAHAM, M.D.

On October 9, 1986, in executive session, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron and seconded by Dr. Fitz that the Board not endorse Dr. Weathers' request for reinstatement of Schedule 2 prescribing privileges

FORMAL ACTIONS

On October 9, 1986, the Board unanimously adopted a motion that the Board of Medical Examiners include on its formal actions mailing list the local newspapers of individuals who have been the subjects of formal Board actions.

The President instructed that the Board of Medical Examiners notify only AMA and the Federation of licensure denials.

BUDGET 1986-1987

On October 11, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion that the Board approve the 1986-1987 Budget as recommended except for matters relating to salary. The Board also authorized the replacement of the 1981 Chevrolet used by the Executive Secretary.
